

Trees for Less Nursery – Photography Guidelines & Policies

Respect for the Farm & Property

- Stay on designated paths and follow your map.
- Do not climb trees or any farm structures.
- Stay off all farm equipment, including tractors, wagons, and machinery.
- Do not enter private areas, including neighboring fields and wooded areas.
- Dogs are welcome but must always remain on-leash. Owners must clean up after their pets.
- We do have farm animals throughout the property and proceed with caution around them.

Session Etiquette

- Arrive dressed and ready — no changing areas are available.
- Photography sessions must not interfere with visitors, farm operations, or create safety concerns.
- Be respectful of other photographers' space and work.
- Props, small furniture, and backdrops are welcome — please include setup and cleanup time within your booking.
- Drones are not allowed.
- Smoking, vaping, and alcohol are prohibited anywhere on the property.

Booking, Refunds & Rescheduling

- No refunds after booking.
- Rescheduling (due to weather, illness, etc.) must be requested **at least 24 hours in advance** by emailing treesforlessmequon@gmail.com; your payment will be retained.
- No refunds for cancellations or no-shows.
- If you book 2 hours and only use 1 hour, we will not offer refunds.
- Photographers must sign the waiver and indemnity prior to scheduled session

Location & Parking

- Address: **11550 Wasaukee Rd, Mequon, WI 53097**
- Parking is allowed in our main lots and designated paths shown on the map you will be provided.
- No vehicles are allowed in fields or along public roads.
- Bring a wagon or cart if you have more equipment than you can carry.

Facilities & Safety

- A portable restroom is available on-site.
- This is a working farm — tractors, machinery, and active fieldwork may be present. Stay alert and avoid equipment and work areas.
- Minors must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times.
- Electrical fencing is located along the wood lines — keep a safe distance.
- Do not leave personal items unattended; the farm is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged property.
- Photography is allowed throughout the farm in designated areas (a map will be provided).
- Flower fields are not for picking unless prearranged.
